The ability to make correct decisions makes life more practical and dynamic. The Decision making process also plays an important role in identifying opportunities and helps in choosing the right opportunity. This ability is a conceptual and it is formed by co-ordination, combination and composition of various factors. In order to solve the questions and problems we face in life, we take decisions based on our knowledge, experience, skill and outlook. Naturally, being able to make decisions and implement them contributes to human development and makes life easier.

When we are unable to make decisions, or make decisions latewe face problems, failure and difficulties. If you are unable to make decisions related to your personal life, it will affect your life. We should make conscious efforts to make our decision-making process and ability efficient, effective and fast by imbibing the following aspects.

- ❖General Knowledge: General Knowledge is formed by perception and the assimilation of information. It is the understanding of what is happening around us in social, political, economic, religious, cultural, educational etc. and the reasons behind it.'Knowledge is power' and when it is with us, it becomes easier to take quick and appropriate decisions with increased confidence.
- ❖ Experience: Experience is our true teacher and guide. Confidence increases tremendously if it is accompanied by a bundle of experience. In order to gain experience one needs patience, study, hard work and determination. Experience is multi-disciplinary and a single experience does not add any knowledge or skills. Naturally, along with experience comes our curiosity and an attitude of understanding and learning. Experience gives confidence and enhances decision-making ability. Always look at how your experience will be broad and multifaceted as it will increase your decision making capacity.
- ❖Skills: Skills are of two types. One is life management skills and the other is professional management skills. Both skills are complementary. These skills are acquired through practical application of knowledge and experience. We need to diversify our operations and dramatically improve our management practices and operations in order to master our skills. Once you develop the skills of diplomacy, responsibility and accountability, your decision making ability is strengthened.
- *Attitude: When doing our daily work, we have knowledge, experience and skills but if our attitude is negative and narrow then it becomes 'water on the back'. That's why your perspective while working becomes very important. Attitude, however, deals with the values, values and morals of your immediate life. So your attitude is an important factor influencing your decision-making ability.
- Inter Personal Relations: In your office or place of business, you interact with a total of four types of people. Your superiors, your juniors, your colleagues, and people who come to the office

- for work. All these four people are full of knowledge, experience, and skills. Therefore, it is imperative to imbibe some things from these people without giving the appearance of 'I understand everything'. Also, if we have a strong interpersonal relationship with all four elements, it also influences our decision-making process, and we make decisions in a more confident manner.
- ❖Communication Skills: If you have warmth and gentleness in your communication along with accurate and appropriate communication, people will express themselves to you. The more information is known through open communication, the easier and easier the decision-making process becomes. When communication increases, the decision-making process becomes faster. Accuracy in the decision-making process can also be achieved as reservoirs of information and experience which are opened up through communication.
- ❖ Motivation & Encouragement: Motivation and encouragement play an important role in life's progress and work. Motivation and encouragement have declined dramatically over the past few decades. Due to this extreme depression and instability is experienced in social life. Individuals need to be self motivated, which should come from within. Self motivation requires alignment of the mind and brain and a positive thinking style to be adopted.
- ❖Unknown fears: If I make a decision, it won't go wrong, right? If he fails, I will not be in trouble, right?, there are many types of unknown fears seen in life. Hence, an attitude is developed that it is better not to decide than to make a decision. Hence to overcome such fears it is necessary to instill confidence in a person. Such confidence is built only through knowledge, experience, skills.

The more accurate, strong and fast the decision-making process is, the more success and development is guaranteed, and you start living a simple, easy, straightforward, free and happy life.

In today's competitive age in business, it is very important to take the initiative, accept challenges and handle them successfully. Do you have the skill set to solve problems or find answers to questions? This is very important. In short, you should be able to identify the problem or question, understand the issue and find the right solution. But we are never trained in how to solve problems. When faced with such a situation, our reaction is usually:

- We get scared or anxious and want the problem to go away.
- We find a solution and decide that it is the right solution.
- **❖** Blame someone.

We primarily need to understand, "What exactly is a problem?" A 'problem' is when there is a gap between our goals and what we are doing, which cannot be bridged. Problems are often further complicated by differences with others. But at such times we should remember two things. One is that problems are an integral part of life and we cannot avoid them. Secondly and more important, problems are an invaluable opportunity to demonstrate our skills and expertise.

How to solve problems

- ❖ Understand the problem: Understand exactly what is the problem and what is the situation created by the problem? When working in a team, remember that each person may have a different perspective. The approach of each team member to the problem may be different. A simple thought is that no one will be at a loss if the problem is understood and a solution is reached. The best solution is the one which everyone feels is the easiest. Hence it is important to take a consensus on the decision.
- ❖ Brainstorming: Brain storming is a great and well-known method of arriving at an answer. In this, everyone in the group presents their own opinions related to the related topic, no one's proposal is criticized or ridiculed. So there is a lot of scope for creativity. In this method many different ideas are generated in a short time, or options are available to solve the problem.
- Select an option : Select an option: check all the

options that are available. Review pros and cons of each option. Use the options that you think are the best to solve the problem..you may be able to solve the problem by combining various options.

Especially when the situation is complex, if the answer is difficult to find, writing down the options helps a lot. Also consider how to implement the option. Decide how you will handle obstacles if they arise. The trouble shooting process itself is time consuming; but if the problems are properly focused on and given time, the problem reduces. What is the biggest obstacle? A major obstacle in the way of problem solving is the policies we have already built. Often we form an opinion about the problem without seeing the whole picture. Due to this we cannot arrive at exact answers.

These policies can be of the following types:

- The problem is simple
- The problem is difficult
- Similar to an earlier solved problem
- The problem is impossible to solve
- No Problem

What are the barriers to problem solving

The problem should be broken down into smaller problems, so they are manageable. Our experiences and knowledge can be used in problem solving. We can learn a lot from our experiences and use these experiences to solve problems. Solving a problem sometimes requires persistence.

❖ Use imagination in problem solving: ②some problems are such that no concrete alternative answer can be found. It is necessary to find some new way to solve the problem. But to solve the problem in this way, thoughts should not be stuck in any frame, prejudice and vision should be positive.

If you have the courage and confidence to do something new, you can solve problems with imagination.
